### HAPPENINGS AT WHITTIER HIGH

Whittier High students continue to encourage each other to succeed. **ASB** officers gave out over 1200 signed certificates to students receiving B+ average quarter grades and passed them out in class. They also are giving out teacher awards once a month. And those earning "Cardinals with Class" get a snow cone or popcorn out in the quad. Caring was also demonstrated with the gathering of 15 baskets of food to deliver at Thanksgiving and when 288 students signed up to give blood for a fellow student suffering from leukemia, the Red Cross was overwhelmed!

Recognizing the success in advanced placement at Whittier High, your Alumni Association voted to assist 2 students to attend a Cardinal Advanced Placement conference in November. In addition, we assisted the Drama Club and Football program by putting ads in their programs. We want you to know that each request is recommended by an advisor, carefully studied - and in each instance the students have also invested by fundraising with car washes, etc.

The fall sport teams have done well. Girl's Tennis took League, Cross Country did very well in league, Boy's Water Polo went to CIF as did Girl's Volleyball. Band, Color Guard and Drum Corps placed high in field shows they entered.

The Cardinal and White (the only school newspaper published in the WUHS District) continues to be an avenue for students to recognize and participate in free speech and freedom of the press. The 16 page newspaper addresses local, national and international issues with pictures and drawings and is published four times a year. Whittier High School is living up to its legacy!

In my sixth year as principal I am extremely proud of what Whittier High School has accomplished over the last six years!

We are anxiously awaiting the outcome of our successful WASC (Western Association of Schools and Colleges) accreditation that took place at the end of October. The visiting committee spent the better part of four days with us, validating and celebrating the success of our systemic practices that have led to consistent school improvement. We feel confident that we will achieve a high rating when we receive the report in January, 2014.

WHS also celebrated the completion of new Athletic fields last June; a new all-weather track and improved football field, enlarged baseball and soft-ball stadiums with the ability to play soft-ball and baseball games simultaneously. The new fields, along with our aquatic facility and state of the art gymnasium make the WHS athletic facilities second to none in our district.

## THE CARDINAL COMPUTER ACADEMY

The Cardinal Computer Academy is in its 20<sup>th</sup> year at Whittier High School. The academy goal is to help students make strong connections academically, interpersonally, socially, and with their community. The academy is supported by Whittier High administrators and teachers and headed by Kathleen Bailey, Director of the program and technology.

Technological focus is on computer applications with students earning Microsoft Office Certifications. Web design and programming are also introduced along with entrepreneurial skills and financial literacy.

The mentor program gives the student a chance to interface with professionals from all industry areas. A mentor provides encouragement, guidance, and support to students as they focus on choices for their future.

Professionals and caring adults, retired or presently working, are invited to participate in this one-on-one opportunity to mentor students, who over fifty percent have been identified as “at risk.” The commitment is about 1 and ½ hours, seven times a year.
